What to Bring to Staff Development Weekend 2 and GT1

BED LINENS Bring sheets and blankets for a single bed or a sleeping bag and a pillow. It gets COLD in the dorms, so bring warm bed linens!!

> TOWELS & WASHCLOTHS We don't have them to give you, so bring your own!!

CASUAL CLOTHES THAT ARE GTI APPROPRIATE!! NO short shorts or baggy pants; no spaghetti straps. We will provide your staff shirts for each day of GTI.

*Please bring something red to wear for one of our General Sessions! *Bring your GTI staff polo shirt with the green star on it. We will wear it on Day 4. New staff will receive one at SDW2.

TOILETRIES

Bring soap, a toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, a hair dryer, etc.

ALARM CLOCK & WATCH

You will NOT be allowed to use your cell phone as a time keeper during the day, so bring a watch.

FREE TIME CLOTHES

Appropriate swimwear, a cover up, sneakers and other appropriate Free Time clothes.

SECRET PAL MATERIALS Don't forget note pads, cards or stickers for your

UMBRELLA OR PONCHO

FLIP FLOPS & CARRYALL For taking your bathroom items to the showers and protecting your feet in the hall and bathroom.

COMFORTABLE RUNNING/WALKING SHOES We're spread out across campus this year, and you'll want good shoes to get around. Do NOT plan on wearing flip-flops all day, every day. You'll be sorry! Please remember to bring your GTI staff notebook, Caboodle and Commonality Cards and any fundraising money you've collected. You'll turn in your cash/checks as soon as you arrive at SDW2.

More Suggestions

Bring a small area rug to put next to your bed. This will save you from having to put bare feet on the cold floor in the morning.

Bring a nightlight, which will allow your room not to be pitch black when you have to get up in the middle of the night to go to the bathroom. A robe is a great idea, too!

A big beach towel is great for keeping covered in the community showers.

In addition to your regular bed linens, you're encouraged to bring an extra blanket or throw. Sometimes the rooms get cold, or one of the participants on your hall might need one!

What Not to Bring

No knives, firearms or weapons of any kind, including water weapons, alcohol, tobacco products, unprescribed or illegal drugs, fireworks, valuables, TVs, microwaves, refrigerators, phones, iPads, iPods, laptop computers or two-way radios.

If you bring valuables, you will have the sole responsibility for their safe-keeping; GTI and Oxford College will not assume responsibility for any items that are lost, stolen or damaged. This includes cell phones, iPods, jewelry, expensive sneakers, etc.
